- 2. Adoption of previous Minutes
 - a. Both regular and special December meeting minutes approved
- 3. Meet and Confer Update
 - **a.** Not much to update given the holidays
 - b. Next Meet & Confer is on 1/22/23
- 4. Finance Update
 - a. Account balance is: \$453,560.08

- b. Chris: Holiday party expense is cheap. Typically, it is around \$5000 to \$6000.
- 5. Grievances
 - a. M&M Grievances:
 - i. Vacant supervisor position
 - ii. The supervisor was promoted to manager, but doing supervisor work currently
 - iii. Filed Grievance against the District
 - iv. Good likelihood that we can work something out. The District will do a "Add/Delete", where they can add a "Principal" and remove the "Supervisor" position, as long as EA agrees to it.
 - v. Will take 2 to 3 months to get it resolved.
 - b. 3 added holidays
 - i. Signed into law by Governor Newsom
 - ii. Genocide Remembrance Day, Native American Day, Lunar New Year Day
 - iii. Asked District for their response, and the District hasn't responded yet
 - iv. Filed Grievance against the District
- 6. Closed Session: DWP
- 7. Other Business
 - a. Benefits: Retirement plan
 - i. One of the Stewards received an email from Dan Oliver to bring it to negotiation table.
 - ii. Jack: if board member has knowledge about it, talk to Kenny about it
 - iii. Raymond: Sharon denied some employees from cashing out the annual leave before retirement.
 - 1. Dave: The person being denied leave may be able to file a grievance against the District. But have to find a way to define "Discretion"
 - b. Standby Time
 - i. Chris: Mandatory standby time in enforcement. We will have a meeting soon to discuss increases to standby pay, as this mandatory work is posing financial hardship.
 - ii. It has been voluntary for over 15 years, and now it is becoming mandatory for enforcement.
 - iii. Dave: MOU states that you try volunteer first. If you have no volunteers, then it turns into mandatory. We have a bargaining issue, so we can change the MOU, but this is not possible to file grievance on this.
 - iv. Chris: Meet with impacted folks and learn about the background, before working with the Air District on this issue.
